We are writing to update you on our latest proposals for Pall Mall Liverpool.

Since the last round of consultation, our design team have made several improvements to the proposals, including on the important issue of public open and green space. We will be issuing our revised proposals for a further period of public consultation ahead of submitting a planning application to Liverpool City Council in June.

Two public consultation events are being held. The first event is being held on **Tuesday 18th between 8am and 1pm at 5 St Paul's Square, Liverpool**. The second event will take place the following day on **Wednesday 19th June between 1pm and 7pm at 5 St Paul's Square, Liverpool**.

Pall Mall has an important role to play in extending Liverpool's commercial district and helping to grow the Liverpool City Region economy. It can be a catalyst for Liverpool and the wider City Region, helping to make the city the obvious choice for leading companies looking for a base in the North West of England. Pall Mall Liverpool will help attract and retain talent within the city and we expect it to deliver 2,400 jobs with over 2,000 knowledge-intensive jobs.

Set within attractive city centre gardens our vision is to set a benchmark for working environments in Liverpool by creating a distinct city centre destination for workers, residents and visitors to enjoy.
