

## Nuisance / Anti-social behaviour related call logs for the area of Drury Lane / Beetham Plaza

After reports from local residents and businesses stating that there was increasing anti-social behaviour in the area Merseyside Police have searched force systems, looking at all call logs received from the area relating to nuisance behaviour.

The below list is all calls from the period 1<sup>st</sup> April 2018 – 31<sup>st</sup> August 2019.

### 2019:

#### **Monday 29<sup>th</sup> July 2019 17:15 hours:**

- Group in the courtyard area outside Etsu, being a nuisance and kicking outdoor seating furniture.

#### **Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2019 15:45 hours:**

- Large crowd of kids near the fountain, no criminal activity but requesting police to move them on.

#### **Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> June 2019 18:15 hours:**

- Large group of youths near fountain, smoking and drinking outside Silk Road Restaurant.

#### **Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> June 2019 19:30 hours:**

- 20+ females around 16-17 years of age being rowdy and drinking bottles of wine.

#### **Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> June 2019 19:00 hours:**

- Large group of youths about 25 in number. Smoking and drinking near fountain with some smashed glass bottles on the floor.

#### **Friday 31<sup>st</sup> May 2019 19:20 hours:**

- Group of underage drinkers in and around the fountain area.

#### **Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2019 19:15 hours:**

- Group of youths in the fountain being a nuisance and generally behaving anti-social.

#### **Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2019 19:20 hours:**

- Same circumstances as the previous day, 5-6 youths.

### 2018:

#### **Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> July 2018 20:30 hours:**

- Group of females drinking and messing about in the fountain.

#### **Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> July 2018 17:30 hours:**

- Large group being rowdy, drinking and riding around on skating board. Disturbing members of the public dining in the two restaurants in the plaza.

#### **Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> July 2018 17:45 hours:**

- Similar circumstances, large group aged 16-18 drinking and shouting at members of the public.

**Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> July 2018 17:45 hours:**

- Same circumstances, 20+ youths in the fountain area being abusive to members of the public.

**Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2018 17:00 hours:**

- 20+ youths in the fountain area being abusive to members of the public and drinking.

**Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> April 2018 18:00-20:00 hours:**

- 6 youths drinking and shouting at members of the public in the restaurant. One of them threw a glass bottle at the restaurant and was lucky not to injure somebody.

From the above call logs it is quite clear that the issues are mainly in the early evenings, throughout the summer months. Merseyside Police are aware of the issue and local neighbourhood officers have been asked to give extra passing attention. We would encourage staff members of nearby businesses to continue reporting issues and work with us to tackle the problem.

The Liverpool Business Improvement District have been made aware to link in with staff at restaurants and the council have been made aware and asked to look in to their CCTV monitoring system for the area.

If the issue persists Merseyside Police can look at alternative methods to disperse the youths, encouraging them to attend local youth centres and other outdoor spaces.
